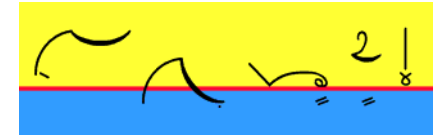


## PITMAN'S NEW ERA SHORTHAND – STROKES/VOWELS & SHORT FORMS

- This is a revolving book with no beginning or end – have the page you are currently learning on top.
- Keep in a small clear wallet, so you can read in spare moments without taking it out. If you cover the outlines columns with clear tape, you can practise writing over them with a pencil, without making a mark.
- Take them everywhere and practise – no more wasted minutes! When they wear out, print more.

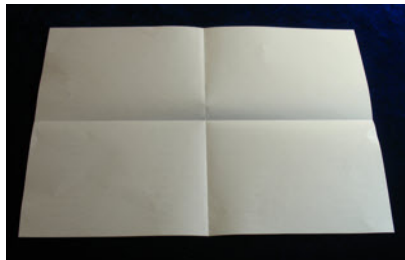

**BEFORE FOLDING:** If your printer does not print to the edges, cut off any margins outside the red border, to ensure the text is central to each page.

## ORIGAMI BOOKLETS – p2 STROKES/VOWELS, p3 & p4 SHORT FORMS IN 2 BOOKS



Face down, fold in half in both directions. Open out.



Face up, fold short sides to the centre. Open out.



Fold in half and cut through centre as far as the next fold.



Open out and bring up the long centre fold.



Push the ends in and the central folds outwards.



Fold over and press creases.

## CONCERTINA BOOKLET – p5 & p6 – SHORT FORMS – MAKES 1 DOUBLE SIZE

The page order is different from the single booklets, so to avoid confusion this booklet's page numbers are circled.



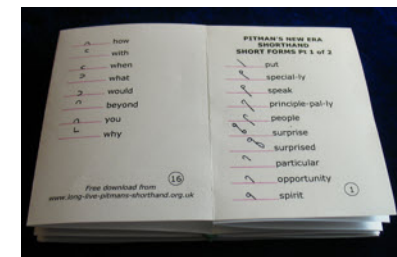
Fold each piece same as origami booklet. Join so the page numbers run on.



Fold in half at the join. Cut along the centre, leaving the end sections uncut. Open out.



Fold in half lengthways and put a loose rubber band/thread between p4-5 and p6-7. Push in the concertina.



Fold flat and press all the creases. The rubber bands/thread are helpful but not essential.



## BLANK RULED BOOKLET – p7

Ruled lines only, slightly wider spaced than above. No need to cut off any margins. Insert your own word lists, facility drills or learning/reading matter.

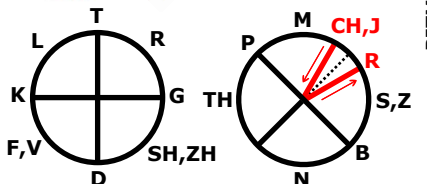
